### **Environmental sustainability**


food and production systems do not deplete natural resources or the ability of the agricultural systems to provide food for future generations

# Food consumption needs to be...

#### **Greener:**

GHG, H2O, N, land-use, biodiversity

#### Fairer:

Animal welfare, fair living for farmers, equity

#### **Healthier:**

Reduced NDCs, reduced manultrition, reduced routine usage of antibiotics in livestock production







## Desirable metrics and tools

- Food system environmental Impacts: eg biodiversity, GHGs
- Food System health impacts eg NCDs, overweight, obesity, malnutrition,
- Food system welfare impacts
- Key consumption and production drivers and pressures
- Existence of strategies and policy responses ( is anyone taking on the problem?)
- Effectiveness of strategies and policy responses: both in terms of awareness raising AND changes in behaviour: are there transformations in the way we produce/consume?
- Measurements that consider total impact (full LCA+ total volume)

FEW & MEANINGFUL Indicators.

We want to see indicators of progress which REALLY speak to policy makers, people and business
